SCHOOL PROFILE 2023

Colégio Pentágono is a private non-religiously affiliated institution **founded in 1971.** With two campuses located in important neighborhoods in São Paulo capital and one in Santana de Parnaíba, Colégio Pentágono is a traditional school highly committed to academic excellence and to the education of world citizens. **The school covers 14 years of education:** 3 years in Kindergarten, 5 years in Primary School, 4 years in Elementary School, and 3 years in High School.





Colégio Pentágono is known for its ranks among the **top schools in the ENEM** (National Exam for High School students) and also for high entrance rates to top Brazilian universities. The last time ENEM ranking was made available was in 2020 - the results corresponded to the exams of the previous year - Colégio Pentágono campuses Morumbi and Perdizes were top 15 in the city of São Paulo and campus Alphaville was the best in the city of Santana de Parnaíba.

INTERNATIONAL DEPARTMENT

Colégio Pentágono counts on the expertise of its International Department, which is responsible for the creation and implementation of the exclusive English language programmes, learn&play and Bridges, both designed to improve the students' performance in the language. The International Department promotes, every year, an internal contest, Pentágono English Olympics, in which students are challenged to deliver presentations according to rigid criteria and are evaluated by an appraisal board. Students who are applying to international universities have the support of counselors and also a college preparatory module as part of Bridges program.

INTERNATIONAL EXAMINATIONS

Colégio Pentágono is a Cambridge English Preparation Center, applying exams to Young Learners (Pre A1 – STARTERS, A1 MOVERS), students in Elementary School (KEY and PRELIMINARY) and High School (FIRST, ADVANCED). The school is also a center that applies the Spanish DELE exams, from Elementary School to High School (A1, A2, B1 and B2).


GRADING SYSTEM
